REGISTRATION:

Camp registration is considered on an individual child basis only. Each child in the family must fill up his/her own separate registration form online and each form is processed in the order in which it is received together with the appropriate payment. Incomplete forms will delay registration.

Your child will not be allowed to attend the day camp if your fees have not been paid. All payments and applications must be submitted online. NO EXCEPTIONS. There is a 60-person limit per week and the application will close and a waitlist will begin when we reach capacity for the week.

Homenetmen Glendale Ararat reserves the right to refuse service or admittance to any child that may be disruptive to the curriculum of Ararat Kids Winter Camp.

PRICES & DISCOUNTS:

The fee for camp is \$400.00 for the first week, \$240 second week (3 days only) or \$90 daily if signed up before December 22, 2022, after that it will be \$100 per day. The fee includes breakfast, lunch, and care from 8:00-4:00. **Same day registration is subject to an \$20 late fee.**

DATE & HOURS OF OPERATION:

Winter Day Camp program will take place December 25-30, 2022 & January 2-4, 2023. Activities are planned 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. The center is open from **8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.** For any other arrangements, please contact Melineh Ebrahiman, the camp director, at (818)486-3115.

DROP OFF AND PICK UP:

Parents will be asked to escort children from the back entrance between 8:00 and 9:00 am and to sign the drop-off sheet. Afternoon pickup will follow the same procedure. We ask that your child is picked up between 3:00 and 4:00 pm.

WHAT TO BRING:

Each child must have a backpack with an afternoon snack, water bottle, and extra set of clothes inside. Ararat Kids Camp will provide all other necessary materials including crayons, hand sanitizer, booklets, arts and crafts materials, and more. Parents are welcome to send any additional items they feel necessary for their own child.

LOST AND FOUND:

Please make sure to label all your child's belongings, including their water bottle, extra clothes, and any other items that are sent to camp in the backpack. All children will be responsible for their own belongings. Should something get lost, Ararat Kids Camp will have a lost and found available for parents to look through. After the completion of last week of the camp, anything left at camp will be donated.

WHAT TO WEAR:

Children should wear comfortable clothes, socks, and sport shoes that cover their toes. Remember to bring a jacket. Please no sandals, crocs, or skirts. We have lots of physical activities throughout the day and want to ensure that children are comfortable, safe, and able to participate in all planned activities.

ABSENCES:

Refunds will only be given for absences with a doctor's note. Each refund request will be reviewed on an individual basis. If approved, the refund request will be given to the accounting office. Refunds are subject to a \$50 processing fee per child and will be made after the conclusion of camp.

ACCIDENTS:

In the event a child is hurt at Ararat and needs emergency treatment, the staff will try to reach the child's parents/guardian or emergency contact. Ararat's accident insurance covers, up to our policy limits, any injuries received at camp to the extent that they are not covered by your health and/or accident insurance.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

No video games, phones, tablets, or electronic devices are allowed between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. If the staff sees a child playing with electronics, the device will be confiscated and returned to the parent upon pick up.
